





- 3. The trustees have given their consent to be appointed as the trustees and as a token thereof signed this deed of trust.
- 4. The office of the trust for the time being shall a situated a No.78 Dr.Ramadass Nagar, Rasathupuram, Kilvisharam -632 509, Walaja Taluk, Ranipet District Tamil Nadu and may be situated at the other places as the trustees may decided from time to time.

5. Objects:

The objects of the trust are:

- a. To promote Rural Development and welfare activities and undertake projects or schemes for promoting Social and Economic Welfare, Health and Education of the Rural Public in Specific and Public in general.
- b. To promote and/or support other organisation formed for furthering the object of the trust by providing administrative, educational, technical monitory and other supports.

xiv. Non formal education for adults and children and promotion of literacy movement.



- f. - g. To organise and manage associations of individual and organizations for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust.
- h. To spread knowledge and education by the publication of or causing to be published books, classics periodicals, pamplets and other literature and/ or by establishing of specific endowments or professionship, lectureship or scholarship and prices.
- I. To provide medical relief by actual payment of expenses for medical treatment of poor or deserving persons.
- j. To take steps to disseminate scientific, technical and cultural knowledge and to raise the standard of life and health among the backward sections of the people.
- k. To give aid for the promotion of agriculture, horticulture, animal husbandry and the like and for research in such subjects.
- I. To promote welfare and recreational activities for children, women and youth.
- m. To erect, establish and maintain burial grounds
- n. Maintenance and renovation of temples and other places of religious, historical, archaeological and artistic importance.
- o. To undertake, support research activities in any field or relevant activities for the furtherance of objects
- p. To aid and assist the advertisement of any other object of general utility.
- q. To do all such things as may be necessary or conjunctive for the advancement of the objects mentioned above, so however that the benefits arising out of the execution of the trust shall accrue to the public at large irrespective of caste, creed, colour, religion, or sex and be subject to the condition that the trust shall not expend or pursue the aforesaid objects outside India.


- r. Establishing, supporting, maintaining or helping by monetary, gifts or otherwise centers for research in all fields of science, including ayurvedic, homeopathic and sidha and in such fields like yoga etc. Therapy and for the purpose of provide necessary amounts to deserving persons in carrying out research.
- s. Establishment, maintain and support to Libraries, museums, reading rooms for advancement of education, culture activities and knowledge in general.

The term "support" in this section shall include technical, administrative, supervisory, monetary training, marketing and educational support.

The term "Monetary" support in this section shall include loans and advances whether interest bearing or not grants donations, awards and rewards.

6. TRUST FUNDS

The Trust Fund shall be the sum of Rs.1000/- (Rupees Thousand Only) that has been settled by the settlor for Public Charitable purposes and objects of general public utility described above, the receipt of which the Trustees have acknowledged and also any other properties, movable or immovable which the trustees may from time to time receive for augmenting the Trust fund or for specified purposes connected with the objects of the Trust not calculated to impede the due working of the Trust arising from the donation, bequests, gifts, legacies or grants in cash or kind or from any other source whatsoever and also of any investments for the time being representing the same (hereinafter called the Trust Fund) and also of the net income from the trust fund. The Trust Fund shall be applied towards the objects of the Trust in accordance with these presents. The Trust Fund shall also be held in the name of the Trust and not in the name(s) of the Trustees. If the object for which this Trust has been created shall fail, or cannot. In the opinion of the Board of Trustees shall be at liberty to apply the Trust Fund or any portion thereof to any other Trust or institutions having objects wholly or in part similar to this Trust.





7. THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- a. The first Board of Trustees shall consist of the following persons.

 - 4. Mr R Suresh Kumar
 - 5. Mr R Mohanraj
 - 6. Mr T.M Dhilipkumar
 - 7. Mr S Suresh Kumar
 - 8. Mrs. Chitra Ramesh
 - 9. Mrs. Rekha Dhayanithi
- (b) The Board of Trustees shall not be less than 3 and not more than 9.
- (c.) Trustee No.1 and 2 Permanent Trustees of the Trust until they resign or are otherwise incapacitated to act as such by the operation of Law.
- (d) in the event of increasing the number of Trustees on the Board, subject to clause 7 (b) supra, by cooption or otherwise the Permanent Trustees as defined in Clause 7(c) supra, shall be entitled to nominate additional Trustees on the Board.
- (e) Vacancies caused by removal, death, retirement resignation or by other reason in the board of Trustees shall be filed by co-option by the permanent Trustees.
- (f) The Managing Trustee shall manage the affairs of the Trust on behalf of the Board of Trustees and shall be the person to sue or be sued on behalf of the Trust.

8. TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES

- A. Trustees No.1 and 2 herein shall hold office for life or until they resign or are incapacitated to act as such by the operation of Law.
- B. Trustees nominated to the Board as per clause 7(d) supra shall held office for such period as may be specified at the time of nomination by the Permanent Trustees which shall be communicated in writing to the Board of Trustees of this Trust.
- C. All other Trustees shall held office for 2 years from the date of appointment or co-option.

- D. Any Trustee may resign from the Board by submitting a written letter of resignation to the Board of Trustees.
- E. Any Trustee who does not co-operate with the Board of Trustees or hinders or acts in a manner detrimental to the Trust in the opinion of the Board of Trustees or in the conduct of the Trustee is not satisfactory in the opinion of the Board of Trustees then, such Trustee may be expelled from the Board and divested of his office in a Trustee by a resolution passed in writing by the majority of the other Trustees.

9. **POWER TO CO-OPT**

The Trustees shall, subject to clause 7 supra have the power to co-opt additional trustees or to fill up any vacancy arising in the Board have the intention and ability to carry out the objects of the Trust shall be co-opted.

10. VACANCIES OCCURING IN THE OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES.

Vacancies arising in the office of the Trustees shall be filled by the remaining Trustees within 3 months of the arising of such vacancies. Where at time the number or Trustees fall below the minimum prescribed in clause 7 (b) supra, the continuing trustees shall have the power to coopt any person(s) to fill up such vacancies.

11. VACANCIES NOT TO INVALIDATE IN ANY PROCEEDINGS


Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees and/or any illegality in the appointment of Trustees, or their proceedings shall not invalidate any prior act or decision of the Board of Trustees.

12. PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUSTEES

The Board of the Trustees may meet as often as may be necessary for the efficient conduct of the Trust. The Trustees may take decision on any matter either at their meeting or by circulation of resolutions on papers. If any of the trustees other than the permanent trustees is absent in 3 consecutive Board meetings without a prior written leave of absent sanctioned by the Board, he shall be deemed to have vacate his office.

13. QUORUM:

The Minimum number of Trustees to be present for conduction a meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be 2 out of which atleast one shall be a permanent Trustee.





14. VOTING:

Each trustee shall have one vote. The option of the majority of the Board of the Trustees present at a meeting shall be final in respect of the all matters relating to the Trust in the event of equality of votes on any matter then the Managing Trustees shall have one additional vote for deciding the matter.


15. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES:

Without prejudice to the general powers of the Trustees to manage the trust, the Trustees shall have the following powers for the management and administration of the trust and for the execution of the objects of the Trust.

- a. To kept the trust properties or apply the Trust fund for the acquisition of any kind of property or assets whatsoever including movable, immovable, actionable claims, securities, shares, stocks or any other form of property.
 - b. To open one or more Bank accounts in the name of the trust anywhere in India and the person authorised by the Board of Trustees, shall have the power to operate such Bank accounts.
 - c. To invest funds of the trusts in any movable or immovable property in any part of the country (India) and further will have the power to sell or vary such investment according to their discretion from time to time.
 - d. The managing trustee shall maintain or caused to be maintained proper book of accounts of the monies, properties, income and expenditure of Trust which shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant duly appointed for the purpose.
 - e. The trustees shall have power to collect rent, interest or other income and invest the Trust fund and vary such investment from time to time and sell or realise such investment for the purpose of the Trust. However, the trustees shall have limited power of mortgage, raise loans or encumber, sell or lease out for the period exceeding one year or otherwise alienate the immovable properties, if any of the Trust unless and until necessity or occasion compels such a sale, transfer or encumbrance, or other alienation of the immovable properties. In any such event, the Managing Trustee shall be competent to sell, lease or encumber or otherwise alienate the properties of the Trust, after due authorisation by the Board of Trustees.

- f. To do all such acts and things as are necessary for the control and management of the affairs of the Trust and for attainment of the objects of the Trust.
- g. To raise such loan or loans for the benefit of the trust and to sign such promissory notes, bills of exchange, hundies or any other financial documents that may be necessary for and on behalf of the Trust.
- h. To settle compromise or compound all or any of the debts claims, outstanding amounts, disputes, demands, actions, suits and proceedings, whatsoever by or against in any manner relating to the trust or refer the same to Arbitration.
- i. To lend or invest the same funds of the trust in such manner as may be decided by the Board of the Trustees.
- j. To incur all such expenses as are necessary for the execution of the trust and powers under these presents.
- k. To raise donations or accept gifts or contributions in cash or kind.
- I. To appoint auditors to audit the accounts of the Trust.
- m. To appoint Legal Advisors for the Trust.
- n. To appoint such staff as may be necessary for the due administration of the said Trust on such remuneration, commission or salary as the Trustees may think proper and suspend remove or replace them whenever necessary.
- o. To reimburse the Trustees towards the expenses which may be incurred by them in the course of or in relation to the affairs of the Trust.
- p. To receive donations, contributions, gifts, bequest legacies and endowments from individuals, charitable or other Trust or institution for the objects of the Trust on such terms and conditions as may be accepted by the Trustees.



- q. To make, alter, rescind and objects, rule or regulations in regards to the conduct of affairs in respect of which any power or duty is invested in them for the convenient advantageous and effective management and administration of the Trust:
- r. The Trustees if they consider if necessary set up management committees for any or more of the institutions set up by the Trust. Such management committees shall consist of members nominated by the Trust from amongst the Trustees and other persons of repute. The Trustee shall have the right to reconstitute and dissolve if necessary, these management committees.

16. ADMINISTRATION

The Board of Trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the Trust, the properties and affairs and to do all such acts, deeds and things which are calculated to fulfil the performances for which the Trust is established. The Board of Trustees shall act through the Managing Trustee.

17. MANAGING TRUSTEE

The first Managing Trustee shall be Mr Ravi Mohan who shall hold office for life or until he resigns or is otherwise incapacitated to act such by operation of Law. After the said Mr Ravi Mohan ceases to hold the office, The Managing Trustee of this Trust shall be named by the remaining permanent Trustee more elaborately described in 7 (c) supra.

The Managing Trustee shall have all the powers vested in the Board of Trustees and shall act on behalf of the Board subject to the overall control and superintendence of the Board of Trustees.

18. MINUTES, ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:

The Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts fo the Trust and a correct record of their deliberations and get the accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

19. NET INCOME OF THE TRUST:

The Trustees shall invest and recover the income of the Trust Fund and shall provide for all costs, charges, incidental expenses, including insurance premium expenses or ordinary repair expanses ect, and all other outgoing and expenses for the management and administration of the Trust. The Board shall at its discretion be entitled to treat any income, gifts or donations received as towards the corpus of the Trust where the donors does not specify any intention to the contrary.

20. CREATION OF RESERVES:

The Trustee shall set apart and credit to the depreciation, sinking or other fund, such percentage or proportion, or the whole of the Income of the Trust Fund as may be determined by the Trustees from time to time. However as and when the balance standing to the credit of such fund exceeds the minimum amount which, the Trustees may from time to time consider sufficient, it shall be lawful for the Trustees to transfer such surplus amount to the General Trust Fund and apply it in the same manner as the Net Income of the Trust Fund.

21. APPLICATION OF INCOME AND TRUST FUND:

The Trust shall, after providing for the aforesaid payment and disbursements and after setting apart any sum for sinking fund, reserve etc, apply and utilise the Net Income of the Corpus of the Trust or the Trust Fund for the fulfilment of all /any of the Public Charitable purposes or objects of the General Public utility referred in para 2 supra by such ways and means as the Trustees may from time to time their absolute and unfettered discretion determine.

22. TRUSTEES AND THEIR RELATIVES NOT TO BENEFIT:

Notwithstanding any power vested with the Trustees under the preceding clauses, no part of the Income of the Trust shall enure directly or indirectly and no part of the Trust shall be used or applied directly or indirectly for the benefit of the Trustees or any person who makes a substantial contribution to the Trust or any relative of the Trustees or the person who makes a substantial contribution.

23. NO REMUNERATION TO THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees shall not be entitled to draw any remuneration from the Trust.

24. LIABILITY OF TRUSTEE OR TRUSTEES

In the professed execution on the Trust and powers conferred, no Trustee shall be liable for any loss to the Trust properties arising by reason of improper investment made in good faith or for the negligence or fraud of any agent or employee employed by him or (by any other Trustee hereof) although the employment of such agent shall not strictly by necessary or expedient or by reason of any mistake or omission made in good faith by the trustee or by reason of any other matter or thing except wilful or deliberate fraud on the part of the Trustees, who alone may be subject to be made so liable.

25. INDEMNITY

The Trustees shall be kept fully indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any loss or liability arising against them for anything done by them in good faith pursuant to the power and authority conferred on them by these presents.

The provision of the Indian Trust Act, 1982 shall apply to all matters not specifically mentioned in these presents. It his however, expressly declared that section 20 thereof will not apply to the Trust.

28. POWER TO MODIFY OR AMEND THE PROVISIONS OF INSTRUMNET OF TRUST:

The Trust shall have power to modify or amend the provisions of the Deed, without determent to the essential objectives of the Trust and in conformity with the provision of section 2(15), 10(22), 11, 12 & 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.


